Catherine Wyatt-Morley is producer of the video **Reasons To Live: Women, Their Families and HIV** and the author of the internationally acclaimed book **AIDS Memoir Journal of an HIV Positive Mother**, (Kumarian Press, 1997) and a newly release work titled **Positive People, Combating HIV and AID** (Trafford Publishing 2006). Wyatt-Morley has continued her authorship with **Time On The Path A Mothers Journey Through AIDS** and is expecting its release. She is Founder and Chief Executive Officer of **Women On Maintaining Education and Nutrition**, (W.O.M.E.N.) a 501© 3 community based organization (1996) in Nashville Tennessee and Founder of the **National Minority Women With AIDS Coalition and Co-Morbidities**(2004). Wyatt-Morley's volunteer efforts have been recognized with a plaque in the **Women's National Hall of Fame**. A woman of color and mother of three she articulates with great personal honesty and integrity the truth to the many issues involved in lives affected by HIV. In addition, she is an outstanding and candid speaker about the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) that has changed her life and the lives of her family.

Her contributions of new awareness relative to this disease specifically to children, teen's, women and to women as concerned citizens, are phenomenal. She is a woman, whose story is about what it is like to be betrayed in married, becoming a single mother infected with HIV and facing AIDS, the dilemma of minority acceptance or rejection, workplace discrimination, including corporate law suits, the reality of risks facing married women, and the effects on the children of infected parents.

Wyatt-Morley carries the experiences and stories of Nigerian, Ghanaian, Thailand, Poland, Canadian and Switzerland women in her quest to educate. An international HIV/AIDS educator, Wyatt-Morley has proven her commitment to outreach, and education through years of knowledge and lives lost to AIDS. By touching our imaginations and our hearts Wyatt-Morley inspires others.
